The following non-means-tested benefits don't take into account your income and savings in the same way as means-tested benefits do, but they do have their own rules which must be met: Contributory benefits. It is a non-means-tested benefit and therefore capital and income are ignored. If you are awarded this benefit you should check to see if you are eligible for other means-tested-benefits or disability discounts. If your income or capital is over a set threshold, you will not qualify, even if you meet all of the other requirements. Therefore, income and capital must be sufficiently low to qualify for a means-tested ...

### Why means testing benefits is not efficient or fair ...

A means-tested benefit is a payment available to people who can demonstrate that their income and capital (their 'means') are below specified limits. It is a central part of the welfare state in the United Kingdom .

Benefits such as Personal Independence Payment and Attendance Allowance that help you with the extra care needs of being sick or disabled are not means-tested. This means they are not affected by your income and savings. Other benefits, like Universal Credit and Pension Credit, are affected by your income and savings – and your partner or ...

### What disability and sickness benefits can I claim? - Money ...

You might be able to get Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit (IIDB). You can get IIDB at the same time as most other disability benefits. Check if you can get IIDB. If you got sick or were injured in the Armed Forces. You might be able to get: one off compensation from the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme or the War Pension Scheme

### Check what benefits to claim if you're sick or disabled ...

Your income and capital must be below a certain limit for you to be eligible to claim any means-tested benefit. This level is an estimate of the amount you need to live on and is set by the government. Each benefit has different eligibility criteria which your income and capital must meet for you to be able to claim.

### Claiming Benefits | How your benefits my be means-tested ...

Savings and means-tested benefits. The amount of savings you and your partner have will affect the money you receive from means-tested benefits. These are benefits based on your savings and income. You can have savings and claim means-tested benefits, but you must stay within Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) limits.

The Basics of Means Testing. If a benefit is means tested, only certain people will be eligible for it. The government agency that administers the benefit will have to determine the means cutoff and figure out a way to verify recipients' means. This is often done with tax returns.
