Tank - Outlet hole inside the tank blocks with grit stopping or slowing fuel flowing to the carburettor. Cap - Cap allows the tank to breath, when the cap vent fails it seals the tank stopping fuel flow. Lines - Leak at connection points and on occasion can block stopping fuel flow. Tap - Leak, causing fire risk.

The problem is as follows: (1) After the engine is switched off, heat from the engine heats the fuel in the fuel line. (2) The expanding fuel (increased volatility) creates pressure in the fuel line from the pump to the carburetor. (3) The check valve prevents the fuel backing up through the fuel pump.

THE CARBURETOR SHOP / Troubleshooting

Check for a lean fuel condition (carb too small, too small primary or secondary jet size or check for restricted fuel filter(s) or fuel lines). Check for vacuum leaks. Check ignition timing (timing may need to be advanced). Check for improperly adjusted intake valve(s) (valve staying open during cylinder firing)

You can also lower the fuel level about 1/8" below the sight plug hole and this will cure it sometimes. The heat from the engine will rise into the carburetor at times and will cause the fuel to boil. Installing a phenolic heat spacer between the carburetor and the intake or a heat shield can cure this.

Before starting the engine, double check for leaks, proper wire routing, any wiring hazards or loose nuts and bolts. This is a great time to visually inspect the overall Sniper EFI install.

Check for air leaks at carburetor intake manifold tube. Check for loose manifold nuts, check for loose carburetor on intake manifold, check for damaged intake gasket. Check float by removing float bowl from the bottom of the carburetor. Inspect float for any cracks or holes.

2 Stroke Bike Engine Trouble Shooting

Fuel restrictions, Low compression, Poor ignition spark, Too much oil in gas or improper air/fuel mixture in carb. Clean carb. jets and air filter; Check for a possible crankcase leak or leaking oil seal. Engine has high rpm but no pulling power. Check clutch gear wheel for worn or greasy clutch pads.
